Total Productive Maintenance (TPM) focuses on maintaining equipment and production systems to promote continual performance with zero breakdowns, defects, or accidents. TPM takes all aspects of manufacturing into consideration, including employees, product development, supply chain logistics and product delivery. Studies have determined labor and equipment to be 1.5 - 2 times more productive after TPM implementation, while process defect rates are down to 1/10th, and manufacturing costs are reduced by 30%. Overall, businesses using TPM reported 5 times greater return on investment.
